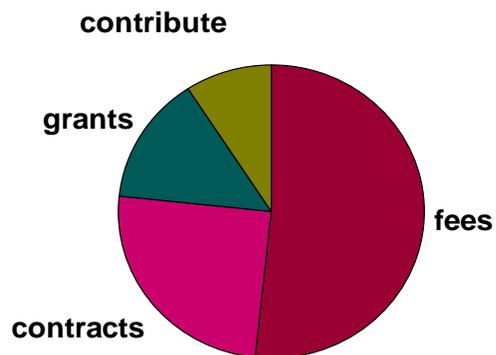

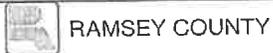

WITH THE CITY OF ARDEN HILLS FOR  
Reconstruction of County State Aid Highway 96  
between Old Highway 8 (County State Aid Highway 77) and Round Lake Road  
S.P. NO. 6284-157, S.A.P. NO. 062-696-030 CTB,  
S.A.P. NO. 187-020-016, S.A.P. 147-020-039**

This Agreement is between the City of Arden Hills, a municipal corporation ("City") and Ramsey County, a political subdivision of the State of Minnesota, ("County") for the reconstruction of Highway 96 between Old Highway 8 (County State Aid Highway 77) and Round Lake Road ("Project").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and the County desire to proceed with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is identified in Ramsey County's Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, Highway 96, in the area affected by reconstruction, is designated County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 96; and

WHEREAS, the Project been designated by the Minnesota Department of Transportation (Mn/DOT) as eligible for County State Aid Highway funds; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been designated as State Project (S.P.) 6284-157 and State Aid Project (S.A.P.) 062-696-030, 187-020-016, and 147-020-039; and

WHEREAS, the County has entered into Agreement PUBW2015-05(R) with the City of New Brighton for the project: and

WHEREAS, the subject road segment is located within the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Project includes, in addition to other items, grading, concrete paving, bridge, concrete curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk, bituminous trail, pedestrian curb ramps, traffic signals, accessible pedestrian signals, turf establishment, utility adjustments and betterments, and related features; and

WHEREAS, construction of storm sewer systems and storm water treatment and infiltration basins will be constructed as part of the Project in accordance with local watershed rules; and

WHEREAS, plans for the Project showing proposed construction have been presented to the City and are on file at Ramsey County Public Works Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Whereas recitals set forth in this Agreement and the exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated in and made part of this Agreement.
2. Responsibility for Design Engineering
  - 2.1. The County has prepared plans, specifications, and proposals for the Project, which will include, among other things, the proposed reconstruction, alignment, profiles, grades, cross sections, paving, concrete curb and gutter, medians, storm sewer, storm water treatment and infiltration basins, sidewalks/trails pedestrian curb ramps, turf establishment, traffic signals, street lighting, accessible pedestrian signals, and utility replacement and adjustments.
  - 2.2. Any costs associated with Project revisions after the completion of plans and specifications will be paid for by the party requesting the revisions. Revisions must be consistent with MnDOT State Aid requirements and are subject to approval by the County.
3. Responsibility for the Right of Way Plan and Acquisition
  - 3.1. No easements and/or right of way are required to be acquired for construction of the Project.
4. Procurement and Award of Contract
  - 4.1. The County has taken bids in accordance with state law and County rules.
  - 4.2. The County has prepared an abstract of bids and a cost participation summary based on the lowest responsible bidder's proposal and it is attached to this agreement as **Exhibit A**.
  - 4.3. The County has requested City's concurrence to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder.
  - 4.4. The County has awarded a contract and will pay the contractor from the Trunk Highway, Local Road Improvement Program, and County State Aid Highway funds identified for the Project.
5. Responsibility for Construction Engineering

5.1. The County shall perform or contract the performance of the construction engineering for all elements of the Project.

## 6. Project Costs

6.1. An estimate of the City's share of the Project costs is attached as **Exhibit A** (cost participation based on Engineer's estimated quantities and contract unit prices). Actual costs shall be based on the quantities constructed and the contract unit prices.

### 6.2. Project Specific Costs

6.2.1. The costs of contractor mobilization, field office operation, erosion control supervisor, and traffic control will be allocated based upon cost participation percentages for the entire Project and based on contract unit prices and quantities at the time of contract award. No adjustments in the allocation will be made if unit prices or quantities vary during construction.

6.2.2. The County will pay 100% of the costs of storm sewer construction needed for Project drainage.

6.2.3. The City will pay 50% of the cost of the sidewalk located within the limits of the City not located on the bridge as shown in **Exhibit A**.

The County will pay for 50% of the cost of the sidewalk/trail on the bridge that is not paid for by the State. The City pays for 50% of the remaining cost of the sidewalk/trail on the bridge. Pursuant to Agreement PUBW2015-05(R) the City of New Brighton is also responsible for 50% of the remaining cost.

6.2.4. The City will pay 50% of the cost of the irrigation system. Pursuant to Agreement PUBW2015-05(R) the City of New Brighton is also responsible for 50% of the cost.

6.3. Except as provided herein, the County and City will participate in the costs of construction in accordance with the Ramsey County Cost Participation Policy, attached as **Exhibit B**. If there is a conflict between **Exhibit B** and this Agreement, this Agreement will prevail.

### 6.4. Design Engineering Costs

6.4.1. The City shall pay the County a design engineering fee equal to 12% of the City's share of the project items identified in **Exhibit A**.

6.4.2. Design engineering fees shall be calculated based on the final contract quantities and unit prices.

6.5. Construction Engineering and Administration Fee

6.5.1. The City shall pay the County a construction engineering and administration fee equal to 12% of the City's share of the items identified in **Exhibit A**.

6.5.2. The construction engineering and administration fee shall be calculated based on the final contract quantities and unit prices.

7. Payment Schedule

7.1. Construction costs and design and construction engineering will be invoiced at the time of substantial project completion, as determined by the County.

7.2. Payment will be made within 30 days of receipt of an invoice.

8. Maintenance Responsibility for Project Elements

8.1. *Signals*. The City shall be responsible for maintenance of painted signal poles and mast arms within the limits of the City. The County will perform maintenance on the EVP systems and will bill the cost to the City.

8.2. *Sidewalks*. The City shall be responsible for maintenance of concrete sidewalk and pedestrian ramp construction on the north side of Highway 96 east of the easterly ramp terminal intersection. Maintenance includes, but is not limited to, snow, ice and debris removal, patching, crack repair, panel replacement, and any other maintenance activities necessary to perpetuate the sidewalks in a safe, useable, and aesthetically acceptable condition.

Ramsey County is responsible for maintenance of the sidewalk/trail located west of the easterly ramp terminal, including sidewalk/trail on the bridge.

8.3. *Pond Maintenance*. Upon completion of pond construction, the County shall own and provide for all operation and maintenance of the pond basin and all facilities a part thereof located in the northeast quadrant of the interchange.

9. The City grants the County temporary construction easements over all City owned rights-of-way and property within the limits of the Project for use during construction at no cost to the County.

10. The City and County shall indemnify, defend, and hold each other harmless against any and all liability, losses, costs, damages, expenses, claims, or actions, including

attorney's fees, which the indemnified party, its officials, agents, or employees may hereafter sustain, incur, or be required to pay, arising out of or by reason of any act or omission of the indemnifying party, its officials, agents, or employees, in the execution, performance, or failure to adequately perform the indemnifying party's obligation pursuant to this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute a waiver by the County or the City of any statutory or common law immunities, limits, or exceptions on liability.

11. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by mutual agreement of the parties.
