

2016 RECYCLING GUIDE

HERE IS A REMINDER OF WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR RECYCLING SERVICES...



Q. What is Single Sort Recycling?

A. Single Sort recycling allows you to throw **all household recyclable materials into one cart**. No sorting or separating of the materials is needed.

Q. Who is my residential Recycling hauler?

A. Republic Services is the City's recycling hauler. Please contact **Republic Services** with any questions.

Q. Does Republic Services accept clothes or linens?

A. Republic Services does NOT accept these items at the curb. Please donate these items. Contact **Ramsey County** at 651-633-EASY (3279) answered 24/7 or visit RamseyRecycles.com.

Q. What time should I have my recycling at the curb?

A. Please have your recycling cart to the curb by **6:45 am** on your collection day. Place your recycling cart on one side of the driveway and your trash cart on the other side.

Q. Who do I contact if my recycling was missed?

A. Please contact **Republic Services** directly.

Q. What should I do with household hazardous waste and electronic waste materials?

A. Contact **Ramsey County** at 651-633-EASY (3279) answered 24/7 or visit www.RamseyRecycles.com.

Q. Do I have to rinse and clean out recyclables?

A. Yes. Please rinse and clean out contaminants from products.

Q. What types of materials are occasionally found in recycling carts that are NOT to be recycled in your cart?

A. Examples of prohibited materials found in recycling carts include: kitchen utensils, pots and pans, dishes, ceramics, children's toys, rubber hoses, fans, electronics, toasters, Styrofoam, plastic film, storage containers, light bulbs, oil and pesticide containers, aerosol cans, car parts and other metal items such as rebar, nuts, bolts and other similar items. Please contact **Ramsey County** at 651-633-EASY (3279) answered 24/7 or visit RamseyRecycles.com for ways to properly recycle these items.

IMPORTANT NOTE: *If your Service Day falls on or after a Holiday, your service will be delayed one day that week.*



Recycling is picked up **EVERY WEEK** on the same day as your trash pick up service.

Place recyclables in the cart "loose"...not inside bags.

You have Trash & Recycling Collection on *Tuesdays* if you live **South of I-694**

You have Trash & Recycling Collection on *Wednesdays* if you live **North of I-694**

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ACCEPTED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART.

Paper & Cardboard

- Newspaper & Newspaper Inserts
- Magazines and Catalogs
- Junk Mail and Envelopes
- Office & School Paper
- Phone Books
- Cardboard (flattened & placed inside cart)
- Cereal and Cracker Boxes
- Shoe and Gift Boxes
- Toothpaste, Tissue, and Medication Boxes
- Brown Paper Sacks/Bags



Cartons

- Milk Cartons
- Soup and Broth Cartons
- Juice Boxes and other Paper Cartons



Glass

- Food & Beverage Glass
- Bottles and Jars



Metal

- Food and Beverage Cans



Plastic Containers (#1 - #7)

Bottles & Jugs:

- Dishwashing Liquid and Detergent Containers
- Shampoo, Soap, and Lotion Bottles
- Water, Soda, Juice, Pop, and Milk
- Ketchup and Salad Dressing



Cups and Containers:

- Yogurt, Pudding, and Fruit
- Butter/Margarine, Whip Cream, Cottage Cheese, and other Food Containers

NO! Do NOT

Recycle These

- Garbage
- Food Waste
- Food Tainted Items
- Paper Towels
- Paper Napkins
- Egg Cartons
- Batteries
- Cloths & Linens
- Musical Greeting Cards
- ***No Plastic Bags***
- Plastic Freezer Boxes
- Food boxes from the Freezer
- Ice Cream Cartons
- Aluminum Foil
- Styrofoam Cups/Plates or Packaging
- Aerosol Cans, Propane Tanks or Helium Tanks
- Hazardous Liquids/Waste
